





unveiled the new Nismo Juke alongside a locked up "pre-production" 2014 Nismo 350Z. The Juke seems like it will be an interesting piece, something I could use as a daily driver year round. Course the Juke was also pre-production, so there was no way we could get a look at more than the outside. Both were painted with a similar paint, pretty good looking. There was no info available at the show about any changes to the Nismo, but an internet search found that the changes are all cosmetic, no performance improvements. The rumor is that the next Z will be smaller and lighter and coming out as a 2015 model. Sounds like just the ticket. I hope Nissan realizes that they need to keep the same level of performance as the current Z, at least at the highest trim level. Any drop in performance will be a disappointment to the Z enthusiasts. A lower base level to compete with the FRS / BRZ twins would be acceptable. Perhaps they'll let us know more at the National Convention in August.

# 2013 Midwest Z Heritage Car Show June 14 8 15, 2013

The Indy Z Car Club is hosting this year's Midwest Z Heritage Car Show in Brown County, Indiana. Start planning now to get away to rustic Southern Indiana and drive some twisty back roads, shop in the art colony of Nashville, hike in Brown County Park, visit the architectural gems of Columbus, IN, and explore the nearby wineries.

Visit <u>www.midwestzheritage.com</u> for registration information, limited to the first 140 cars. The car show has expanded their format and Datsun Roadsters, Infiniti G's and Nissan GTR's are invited to attend, sponsored by Dreyer and Reinbold Infiniti.

The hotel is now taking reservations! The Season's Lodge in Nashville, Indiana has only 52 rooms. Twenty of those rooms are Standard rooms (\$109. Plus tax) and thirty-two rooms are Deluxe (\$129. Plus tax). These are slightly larger and have a fridge/microwave. One night's deposit required when booking and you may cancel up to 48 hours prior to arrival.
