are other tasks that need a lead. We have a couple car show location ideas we are pursuing, but are open to other suggestions. We are also looking for ideas and suggestions as to a Friday event(s), host hotel and social dinner locations.

August 25 - Geneva Concours d'Elegance. We have registered as a club for the car club area. An Evite has been sent out. In late August the town of Geneva, IL hosts a major automotive event called the Geneva Concours d'Elegance. The organizers offer a reserved parking lot behind the County Court House for individuals and car clubs for a \$20.00 charitable donation per car (Beneficiary: LIVINGWELL CANCER RESOURCE CEN-TER). The Court House parking lot is 1/2 block off of 3rd Street down the entire length of which the Concours entrant's cars are displayed. So, you literally step out of your car and you are in the middle of the event. The parking lot is limited to registered vehicles but is also viewed by event spectators. You may arrive and depart at your leisure; however, the event starts at 10:00am and it would be best to arrive before that time. As mentioned, it is located on 3rd Street which is a major shopping location. There are dozens of shops and boutiques and almost as many restaurants and ice cream/gelato/chocolate emporiums. Club members must mail in their registration forms and donation in advance. The organizers have reserved space for us so we should register as soon as possible. The registration form is attached to this newsletter and will also be available on the WCZC website, as well as the Geneva Concours website (genevaconcours.net). Registration Forms must be submitted by August 20, 2019. This is a great opportunity to view some fabulous rolling art, historic vehicles and show our car club colors at an event the likes of which we don't usually have access. See you there.

Other events under consideration: A club Z drive, our Cruizin' Z car show, cruise nights, trip to Galena or Lake Geneva, drive to Monroe / New Glarus area and brewery. Chicago Wheels tech session.




