Chicago Auto Show by Ty Ozgen

Another Chicago Auto Show has come and gone and once again I would like to give my thanks to Jay Weinberger and Dennis Pecho at Continental Nissan for getting us complimentary tickets. This has been an annual tradition for them to help us attain tickets for this show and it is much appreciated. Thank you!!

As usual, I was able to get to the show by mid afternoon the day of our outing before the big crowds show up but for whatever reason this particular Monday was not crowded at all. Rumor has it that some brands such as BMW and Mercedes Benz did not participate in this event as a cost saving measure and perhaps to use their resources for other venues. I don't know if that was the reason for the smaller crowd or perhaps fear of the Coronavirus. The rest of the participating Z members showed up at 6 PM. As usual the first place we headed to was the Nissan display. They did have a 50th Anniversary 370Z dressed in silver and black on display for the public. For as long the as the 370Z has been out (2009), it was still attracting a crowd. And why not? It is still a great affordable sports car with beautiful lines and a manual transmission. The new Z will hopefully be out in the near future and we will wait patiently to see what it looks like.

I know it's been tough for Nissan lately with the December sales of Nissan/Infiniti down 29.5% and 9.9% for the calendar year. Nissan is not alone with this as other manufacturers are also having there share of financial woes. The new Altima and the Nissan Kicks seem to be the only bright spot, as far as sales are concerned. Our beloved Z was down 21.8% for December (158units) and down 31.3% for the calendar year (2,384 units). This is pretty close to the number of Z's sold for model year 1996 (2,629 units). If you recall our beloved Z was absent for several years until the "new" 2003 350Z came out. For now it is still available minus the roadster version. We shall see. At least the new Sentra is out now and they did have one on display at the show It certainly is an attractive compact and hopefully put more life into our dear Nissan brand.

Getting back to the auto show, Nissan had a lot of interactive displays. One was like a game show where the crowd could stand behind a computer screen and answer trivia questions as quickly as possible about Nissan. Several members joined in to participate in addition to a few other regular people from the crowd. I think we all thought being Nissan fans we would win this contest easily but we were wrong. The winner was some young kid, probably 14 years of age. Who was he and how did he know the answers? Hmmm I feel we had all the questions answered properly yet he probably had quicker reflexes. Those young kids!!! We all got consolation prizes including a lighted cell phone holder for taking those "selfies" and a cell phone portable battery charger.

It was a lot of fun as we posed for the photo shoot. Nissan did have a 2007 Frontier pickup on display with over a million miles on it. It had the original 4 cylinder engine as well as the 5 speed transmission. Quite impressive!!

Another one our favorites had a prominent display at the Chicago Auto Show this year. It was none other than Turtle Wax. I saw our friend Rod demonstrating the Turtle Wax products to the public and I couldn't help but chime in. He was showing off the new Turtle Wax Hybrid Ceramic Polish and Wax which was not available when we visited them last May. He was using the product with an orbital buffer on top of a scratched black hood. It was quite impressive as it took car of the scratches and dull finish on the paint. Off course I mentioned how pleased I was with their products to him in a loud voice so that the audience could hear it. I'm sure the crowd thought I was paid to say that but it is true. They make a lot of great products.

So you might ask what my favorite cars were at the show. As far as the Nissan products, I still like the Rogue, especially with the SL trim. It just looks right. No wonder it has been a great seller for them. The new Sentra looks like a winner as well. In the Infiniti line the Q60 coupe is just plain beautiful to look at, inside and out. Rumor has it that its twin turbo V6 will power the new Z. As far as the American lineup, the new Corvette is definitely a gorgeous car. We all had seen pictures of it but to see it in person, it was just as appealing. It has some very nice lines on it. The new Z will have a tough act to follow but from what I have heard, it will also be a "looker". A car that you want to turn back and look at as you walk away from it. A big SUV that caught my fancy was the Lincoln Aviator. It's just a big classic American luxury barge for the family. I know it's a boat but it also had a nice look to it and exuded luxury.

Overall I had a lot of fun this year at the show and again I appreciate Jay and Dennis for getting us tickets.
