In Z news, it appears that production of the 370Z has stopped and there are few if any 370Zs left at dealerships. Nissan reports only 28 370Zs were sold in the first quarter of this year, in the US. There will be no 2021 370z and it appears likely that the next Z will be introduced at the end of this year, as a 2022 model. Nothing official from Nissan and who knows how the semi-conductor shortage and other supply chain issues will affect release rate and production. There have been a few sightings of the new Z in the US, which I assume is being used for testing purposes.

Evites have been issued for Branson and ZCon events to gauge interest and determine who will be attending.

Memeber's Column

Walt Kreitling

It was Alfred Lord Tennyson who observed that, "In Spring a young man's fancy lightly turns to thoughts of Love". Recently another less renowned observer of the effects of Spring (who might look a bit like me) opined that, "In Spring a car freak's fancy turns to what has been hibernating in the garage all winter". This led to a suggestion that perhaps a visit to a local Winery and a drive through the surrounding countryside might be just the event to bring club members and their favorite vehicles together and enjoy the Spring weather that has finally arrived.

To that end, 9 members; the Pleiters, the Kreitlings, the Osborns, the Phillips, and Jim Koolish all gathered at Acquaviva Winery in Maple Park, IL. Acquaviva is, to the best of my knowledge, the Wine Capital of Kane County, IL (also may be the only winery in Kane County) and is located about 5 miles west of Elburn, IL on Hwy. 38. It is a significant installation, with an imposing main building, a B&B, patio and pergola, with vineyards across the street and behind the winery. The environment was reminiscent of California or even Tuscany if you disregarded the grain elevator, silos and the Union Pacific Railroad in the distance. All kidding aside, it is a very pleasant place to sip good wine and eat good food. The weather cooperated as well.

We were seated together, at a collection of tables under the pergola, and were offered a variety of both red and white wines produced on location. The menu offered a variety of Italian dishes, pizza, seafood pastas, steaks, and salads. Among the selections made were homemade gnocchi, pizza (Margherita as I recall) Panko crusted Whitefish, and Rigatoni Bosciola (pasta tenderloin tips and mushrooms in sauce).

Acquaviva also has tastings and tours but we did not take advantage of either. After our meal and some socialization, which we all appreciated after our year of Covid isolation, we adjourned to our Zs where we "socially distanced" on a tour of the surrounding area. The tour covered 45 miles of my favorite type of road, two lane blacktop through the countryside. The group travelled from Maple Park to Big Rock, Kaneville, Little Rock, just south of Sandwich, then to Hickley and returning via US 30 to the Sugar Grove area, where we went our separate ways to our respective homes. Altogether a pleasant drive, little to no traffic and only three stoplights; one at the beginning and two at the end. Trees were leafed out and corn fields were just beginning to show signs of corn that by July would be 3 or 4 feet high. Roads were mostly section roads meaning they were straight, but some obscure byways were found with curves and hills to make driving interesting. No one got lost and no mechanical impairments were suffered by the participants. Altogether a pleasant Spring day. We look forward to more such events this summer, to enjoy the fellowship of members.
